



Sermon Text:

Ephesians 3:14-21 NIV

For this reason I kneel before the Father, from whom every family in heaven and on earth derives its name. I pray that out of his glorious riches he may strengthen you with power through his Spirit in your inner being, so that Christ may dwell in your hearts through faith. And I pray that you, being rooted and established in love, may have power, together with all the Lord's holy people, to grasp how wide and long and high and deep is the love of Christ, and to know this love that surpasses knowledge—that you may be filled to the measure of all the fullness of God.

Now to him who is able to do immeasurably more than all we ask or imagine, according to his power that is at work within us, to him be glory in the church and in Christ Jesus throughout all generations, for ever and ever! Amen.

Good Life Challenge: Week 1

Love lives, and love is lived out in community, A Rule of Life will fail if lived outside of the people of God, Gathering as the people of God isn't an afterthought or a sidebar or just one of the things we do, but it is central to what it means to be a Christian. In community we are strengthened, nourished, encouraged, and edified. This week we challenge you to take your church involvement to another level. You might:

- Join a Men's Group or Women's Group
- Start your own Small Group (Talk to a pastor if you don't know how)
- Join a Bible Study
- Join a Sunday School Class
- Serve at Helping Hands or Church in the Park once a week
- Find a prayer partner
- Share a weekly meal with someone

By the end of this series, it is our hope and prayer that you will develop a Rule of Life. A Rule of Life clears our busy and chaotic paths so that we can grow into greater intimacy to the One we are created to resemble. A Rule of Life looks different for everyone. It takes time to develop, accountability, and discernment. It can include practices and habits such as study, silence, prayer, intentional community, service, care, and rest.

Example of a Rule of Life: Love God; Imitate Jesus; Love my neighbor.

- Read guided prayers every morning and every night.
- Read 1 book per month that will edify my walk with Jesus.
- Read through the Psalms 4 times this year.

Rest

- One day of rest.
- Play basketball 2 nights a month.
- Abstain from Social Media 4 days a month.
