

with Pastor Tara Beth Leach—Steadfast and Faithful

Sermon Text:

Joshua 24:14-15 NIV

"Now fear the LORD and serve him with all faithfulness. Throw away the gods your ancestors worshiped beyond the Euphrates River and in Egypt, and serve the LORD. But if serving the LORD seems undesirable to you, then choose for yourselves this day whom you will serve, whether the gods your ancestors served beyond the Euphrates, or the gods of the Amorites, in whose land you are living. But as for me and my household, we will serve the LORD."

Good Life Challenge: Week 4

Faithfulness in Corporate Worship

In the grand narrative of scripture, we discover a faithful God to God's people. Even when the people of God were not, God time and time again showed Godself to be reliable. God is loyal to God's covenant and will always manifest God's steadfast love to God's people. This faithfulness culminates in King Jesus. The call to God's people is a life of faithfulness lived out in obedience. In the Old Testament, we discover the force that pulled people away from faithfulness to God were rival pagan gods. Today, we tend to think rival pagan gods are a thing of the past: however. if we discover the world through the eyes of God, we will see a world full of gods that rival each other for our attention. Prevailing and worldly liturgies and rituals deform us to reflect not the image of God, but the desires of the world. Without an awareness of the rituals that form and deform us, eventually faithfulness to God will become unfaithfulness.

Gathering for worship as the people of God empowers us to be a faithful people to not only God, but also to God's family. When we gather, we are reminded that we belong to a larger community and narrative. When we gather for worship we remember who we are and whose we are. But today's average Christian only attends worship 1-2 times a month! No wonder "rival gods" captivate our hearts. Perhaps for your Rule of Life you might want to add "faithfulness to the weekly worship gathering." If you are faithful already, perhaps you want to begin preparing your heart before and during worship.

Before you gather for worship on a Sunday morning, consider 10-20 minutes of prayer and worship. Ask God to open and soften your heart. Ask God to help you hear the promptings and leadings of the Spirit. As you enter the Sanctuary, continue practicing the presence of God by thanking God for meeting you there. Continue on in worship with a prayerful and open heart. Don't be afraid to express your depths of joy, praise, sorrow, or yearning as you sing. To better absorb the sermon, get a prayer journal and take notes so you can refer back to them.

Example of a Rule of Life:

- Meditate daily on the teachings and life of Jesus.
- Do a prayer walk around my neighborhood 3 times a week.
- Break bread with a neighbor once a month.
- Pray daily that I might be used by God for God's glory.
- Say the Lord's Prayer morning and night.
- Gather for worship faithfully every week.


