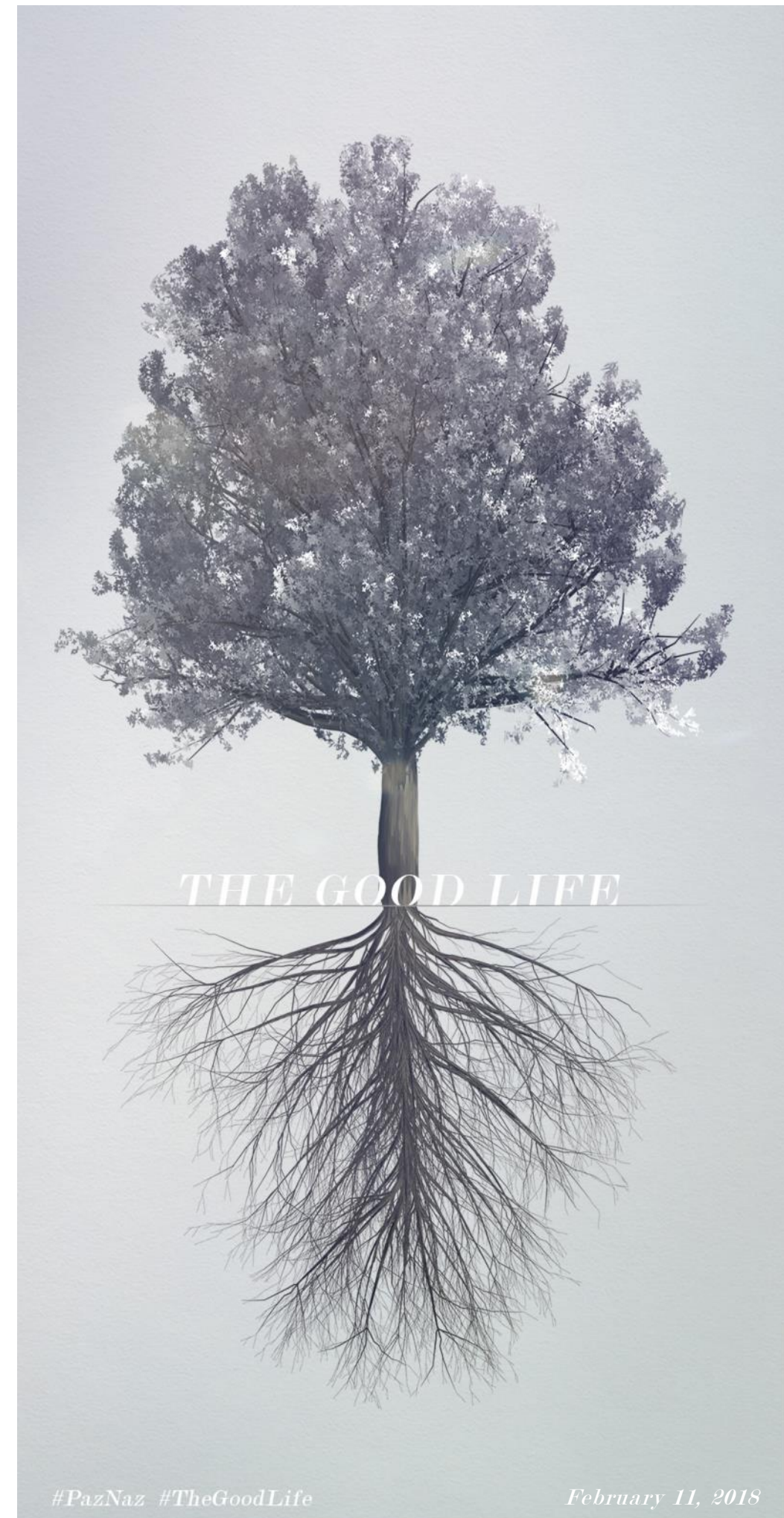

with Pastor Tara Beth Leach—Two Kinds of Wisdom

Sermon Text:

James 3:13-18 NIV

Who is wise and understanding among you? Let them show it by their good life, by deeds done in the humility that comes from wisdom. But if you harbor bitter envy and selfish ambition in your hearts, do not boast about it or deny the truth. Such “wisdom” does not come down from heaven but is earthly, unspiritual, demonic. For where you have envy and selfish ambition, there you find disorder and every evil practice.

But the wisdom that comes from heaven is first of all pure; then peace-loving, considerate, submissive, full of mercy and good fruit, impartial and sincere. Peacemakers who sow in peace reap a harvest of righteousness.

Good Life Challenge: Week 6 - Find a Wisdom Mentor

Wisdom is not synonymous with knowledge. Instead, wisdom is living in the world in such a way that God and God’s intentions for the world are acknowledged in all that we do. A wise person is marked by the Bible’s great moral attributes and the ability to absorb instruction and correction in a way that leads to insight. Wisdom comes from learning from others who are wise. The foolish find their own way of living, but the wise find others who are wise and learn from them.

An important discipline in the Christian life is mentoring. We don’t automatically grow, gain new ideas, or change behavioral patterns. Most of us need help through examples, relationships, and support. We need mentors. Godly mentors help us grow. Perhaps you feel stuck in your Christian walk. Who in your life could help you? Don’t be afraid to ask for help. Or perhaps you have wisdom to offer younger generations. Who in your midst could you encourage and help grow?

Rule of Life:

- Read the Psalms and Proverbs each morning.
- Read 1 book every two weeks.
- Meet with a neighbor for coffee once a week.
- Bless someone in your neighborhood once a month.
- Sleep 8 hours a night.
- Memorize one Bible verse a week.
- Meet with a mentor once a month.
- Meet with a mentee once a month.
