*Matthew 20:29-34 NIV*

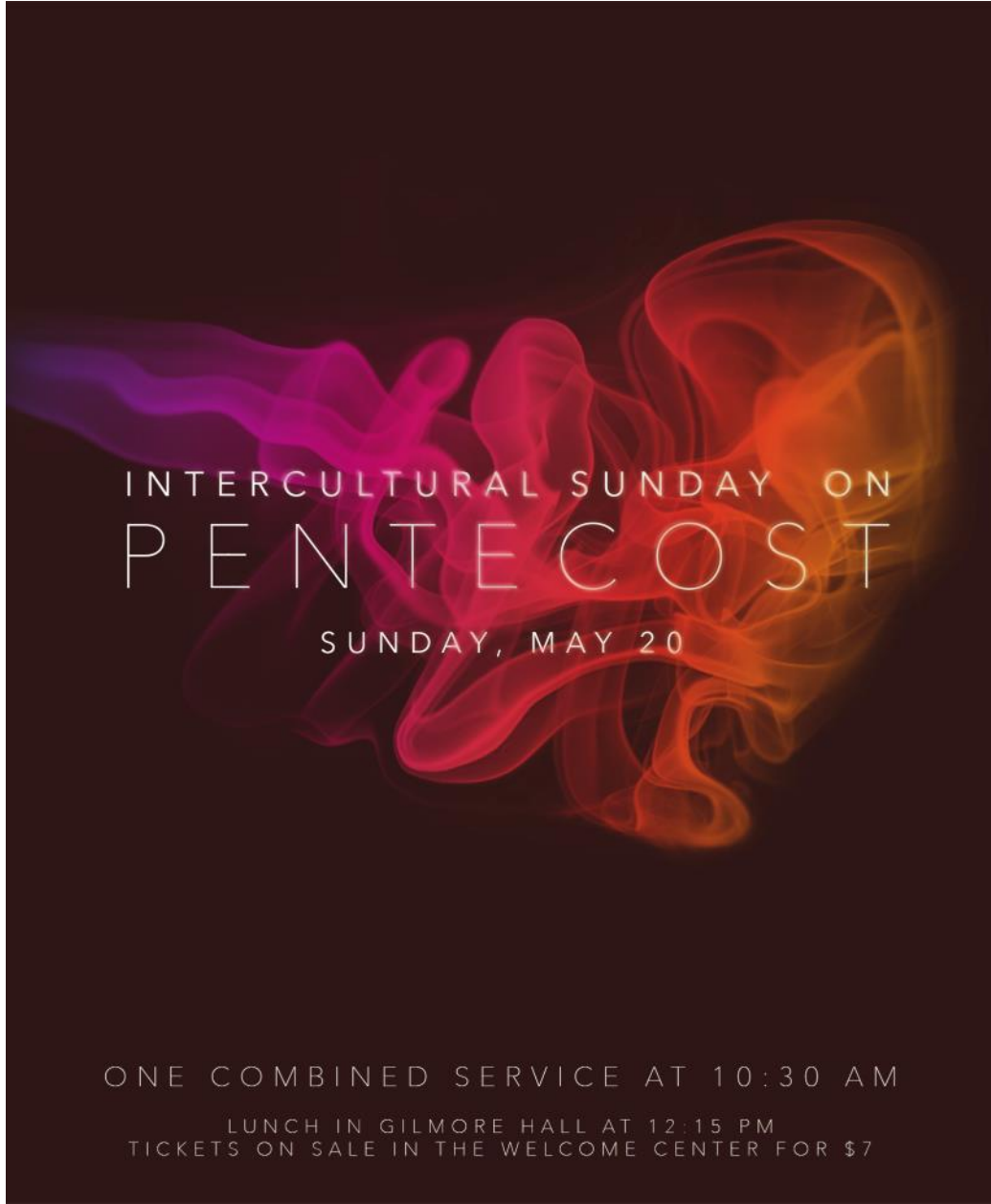
