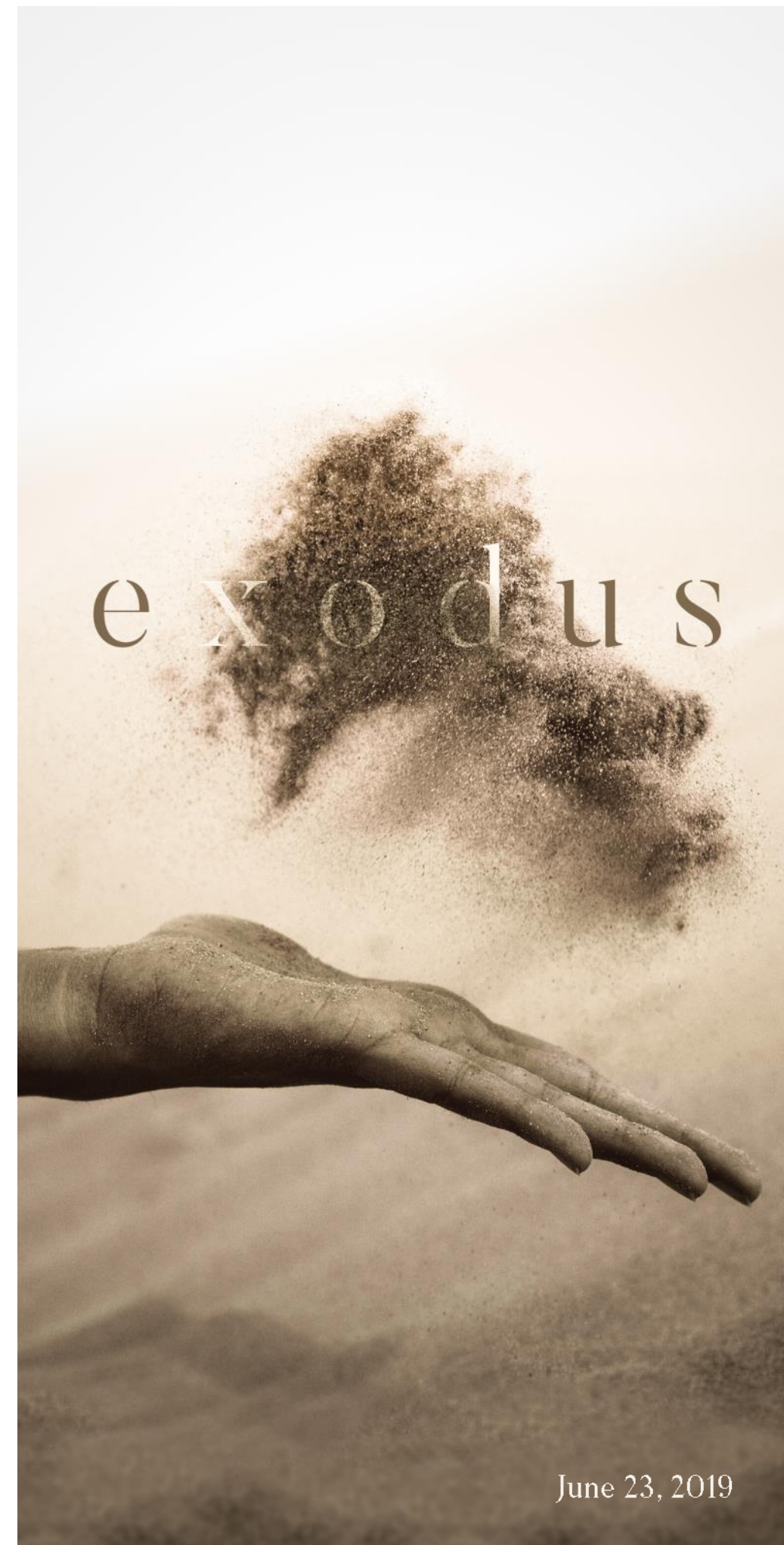

with Pastor Tara Beth Leach—The God Who Sees, Hears, and Responds

Sermon Texts:

Exodus 1:15-22 NIV

The king of Egypt said to the Hebrew midwives, whose names were Shiphrah and Puah, “When you are helping the Hebrew women during childbirth on the delivery stool, if you see that the baby is a boy, kill him; but if it is a girl, let her live.” The midwives, however, feared God and did not do what the king of Egypt had told them to do; they let the boys live. Then the king of Egypt summoned the midwives and asked them, “Why have you done this? Why have you let the boys live?”

The midwives answered Pharaoh, “Hebrew women are not like Egyptian women; they are vigorous and give birth before the midwives arrive.”

So God was kind to the midwives and the people increased and became even more numerous. And because the midwives feared God, he gave them families of their own.

Then Pharaoh gave this order to all his people: “Every Hebrew boy that is born you must throw into the Nile, but let every girl live.”

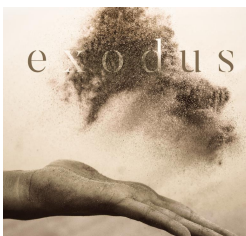
Exodus 2:23-25 NIV

During that long period, the king of Egypt died. The Israelites groaned in their slavery and cried out, and their cry for help because of their slavery went up to God. God heard their groaning and he remembered his covenant with Abraham, with Isaac and with Jacob. So God looked on the Israelites and was concerned about them.

ABOUT THE SERMON SERIES

Exodus tells the story of a people, God’s people, and their deliverance from the empire of Pharaoh’s Egypt. Set a part to be shaped into a missional community; God shows up for God’s people in many forms, in smoke and fire, in water and rock. The elements on the platform are reminders that the God who frees is freeing still, that God leads God’s people in new ways and covenants with them anew.
