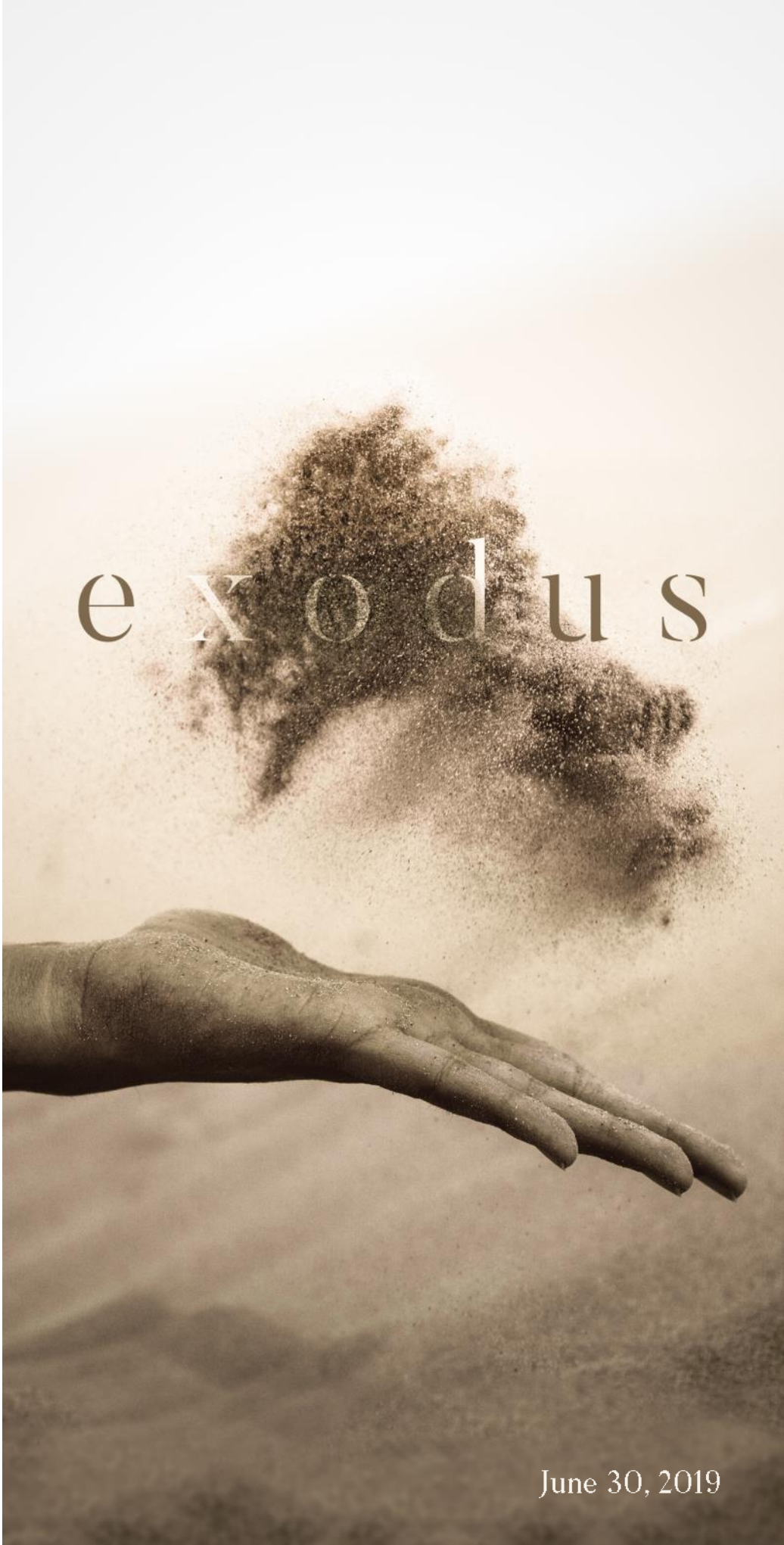

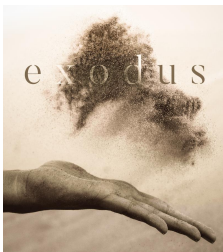

ABOUT THE SERMON SERIES

The elements on the platform are reminders that the God who frees is freeing still, that God leads God's people in new ways and covenants with them anew.
